For your Maker is your husband—the Lord Almighty is his name—the Holy One of Israel is your Redeemer; he is called the God of all the earth.

**Afraid** Jeremiah 1:8

Do not be afraid of them, for I am with you and will rescue you," declares the Lord.

**Afraid** John 14:27

Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.

**Afraid** Psalm 118:6-7

The Lord is with me; I will not be afraid. What can mere mortals do to me? The Lord is with me; he is my helper. I look in triumph on my enemies.

**Alone** John 14:18

I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.

**Alone** John 14:26

But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

**Anger** 2 Thessalonians 3:16

Now may the Lord of peace himself give you peace at all times and in every way. The Lord be with all of you.

**Anxious** 1 Peter 5:7

Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.

**Anxious** Philippians 4:6-7

Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

**Broken** Psalm 147:3

He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

**Crazy** 2 Corinthians 10:5

We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

**Crazy** Philippians 4:8

Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.

**Don't Fit In** 1 Peter 2:9

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

**Don't Fit In** 1 Samuel 16:7

But the Lord said to Samuel, "Do not consider his appearance or his height, for I have rejected him. The Lord does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart."

**Don't Fit In** Ephesians 1:4-6

**Fear** 2 Timothy 1:7

**Fear** Isaiah 41:10

So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

**Fear** Judges 6:12

When the angel of the Lord appeared to Gideon, he said, "The Lord is with you, mighty warrior."

**Fear** Ruth 3:11

**Fearful** Psalm 91:9-12

**Helpless** Psalm 30:2

**Hopeless** Isaiah 43:16, 18-19

**Hopeless** Jeremiah 29:11

**Insignificant** Jeremiah 1:5

**Unloved** John 15:9

**Unloved** Psalm 139:14

I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well.

**Unsettled** Colossians 3:15

Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful.

**Useless** Ephesians 2:10

**Weary** Matthew 11:28-30
